Walt Keller, long time with DEC and now on the Habitat Recreation Advisory Board.

He spoke about an idea he has, that would eliminate the problem of "perched culverts". Fish can not move into the tributaries because the level of the culverts are too high.

Walt thinks a 1 foot? plastic, removable retro fit extension tube could be attached to the culvert. He passed out flexible staws to illustration his concept.

This would create an incline of water flow instead of an impassable shelf. This would be seasonal and no permit would be needed. This could help DEC since no funds are available for relining culverts. TU could play a huge role in this.

I believe Walt is looking for engineering help with the design, and connections to a company that could manufacture them for the right price.

Walt also talked about "in ground water" cold water underground springs so important for brook trout survival.

Dr. John Brako (hydrology expert) is on board with this flexible culvert idea. He says 50% of all culverts are perched. Sometimes a barrier like this is desirable. Being able to select what species you want to pass up stream.

This Idea is under review by TU.
